



2008 Stallion Performance Requirements

For those stallions successfully completing the Final Stallion Approval to complete the requirements for a permanent license through sport

Dressage

Four Year Old Stallion

FEI 4 year old test: 65% or above
Training Level test 4: 63% or above
First Level, test 4: 62% or above

Six Year Old Stallion

FEI 6 year old test: 65% or above
Second Level test 4: 61% or above
Third level test 4: 60% or above

Five Year Old Stallion

FEI 5 year old test: 65% or above
First Level test 4: 62% or above
Second Level test 4: 61% or above

Seven and Eight Year Old Stallions

Third level test 4: 60%
Fourth level test 3: 60%

All the above require a total of 4 tests with 4 different judges. Scores submitted may be from any combination of listed tests per level.

Mature Stallions (9 years and up) – Prix St. George, 60% with a minimum of 5 tests with 5 different judges. These stallions should also present as complete a lifetime show record as possible.

Jumpers

Four year olds level 2-3

Five year olds level 3-4

Six year olds level 5

Seven and eight year olds level 6 and up

Nine year olds and older level 7 and up

Four, Five and Six year olds, five clear rounds at 5 different USEF A rated shows including at least one round at level 5. All other rounds must be a minimum of the age appropriate levels listed above, i.e. a five year old may not submit rounds at level 2-3 completed at the age of five.

Seven and eight year olds, five clear rounds at 5 different USEF A rated shows including at least one round at level 6 and up. All other rounds; see above.

Nine year olds and older, five clear rounds at 5 different USEF A rated shows including at least one round at level 7 and up. All other rounds; see above.

Hunters

Four and Five year olds pre-green

Six and seven year olds 1st year green

Seven and eight year olds 2nd year green

Nine and up regular working or conformation divisions

Place in the top 5 (with a minimum of 8 in the class) at 5 different USEF A rated shows with a minimum of one round in the 1st year green division; i.e., a stallion may not fulfill his performance in sport requirement entirely in the pre-green division.

Combined Training

Four year olds: Novice level horse trials

Five year olds: Training level horse trials

Six, seven and eight year olds: Preliminary horse trials or three day one star

Nine year olds and up: Intermediate horse trials or three day two star or Advanced

Place in the top 20% at 3 different USEA recognized Combined Training competitions with total good points in the dressage phase converting to a minimum of 60% for each year of showing.
