MARE PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

THROUGH THE MARE PERFORMANCE TEST

Mare Performance test – Attain a minimum total score of 75%.
Mares successfully completing the Mare Performance Test at an official AHHA inspection site will have ‘MPT’ designated on her papers and whenever her name appears in a pedigree from that day forward

THROUGH PERFORMANCE IN SPORT

Dressage – Attain an average score of at least 60% in a minimum of five USEF recognized shows at second level test 4 or higher

Jumpers – Place in the top six at five or more Level 5 or higher classes at USEF “A” rated shows

Hunters – Place in the top six at five or more classes at 3’3” or higher at USEF “A” rated shows

Eventing – Complete five USEF Training Level or higher events placing in the top half at each one

Thoroughbreds with significant race records on the flat or in Steeple Chasing may be petitioned.

Mares successfully completing the requirements with performance in sport will have ‘MPT-S’ designated on her papers (wherever possible) and whenever her name appears in a pedigree from that day forward.
